### **Springing into Faith**

Philosopher and theologian Soren Kierkegaard had a dilemma: how do we make sense of faith when logic and reason would tell us otherwise? He certainly wasn't the first to ask the question and he's certainly not the last. But his answer, though unsatisfactory for some, actually can provide for us a great insight into the life of faith. He says that reason and logic will only lead you to the edge of a "broad, wide, ugly ditch." Logically, there is no way around it and there is no way you will be able to make it across. But for Kierkegaard, and for us, "we can only cross the broad, wide, ugly ditch by taking the leap of faith." Faith is what urges us to jump, even if we doubt we'll make the other side. Faith is what allows us to let go of what is possible in our minds, and embrace the mystery of God who does the impossible. This spring, may we have such a bold faith, as to take a leap, trusting that God is carrying us to the other side.


