Dues: \$25.00 per year. This money is used to pay the janitors salary, for cleaning supplies, donations to missions, etc. A check written to Zoar WELCA can be given to treasurer, Karen Hanson, or your workgroup chairperson. We are most appreciative of your financial help!

Funerals or other Events:

We will revolve through our 4 workgroups for events served at the church. The first event will be served by Group A, next event by Group B and so on. If the WELCA chairpersons and workgroups co-chairs feel more people are needed to cover an event, 2 workgroups may be called. With so many employed women in our church, it is very hard to sometimes get enough women to help out. Many have given up their noon hour to help. Some have helped by getting things ready the night before. Some have made a second pan of bars. We need to keep the focus on serving our loving Lord, helping a hurting family, loving each other. Granted many women have job hours to keep, but there are also many understanding bosses in our community as well. When you are asked to help out please remember that most likely there will come a

time that we all will need the church to be there for our own families. Working together can be an enjoyable time visiting and fulfilling the needed service all at the same time. We ask that everyone do what they can to help. It is truly appreciated.

Potluck:

Potluck is typically the first Sunday from November through May.

Workgroups are called upon to serve and clean up for potluck meals. Workgroup members serving should try to contribute some main dishes for the meal. With a little luck, there will be lots of food for a delicious meal. Workgroups are also called to help out for special functions at the church and for funerals. Workgroup chairpersons will call you.

Portion sizes: Please follow these guidelines when asked to bring food to serve at church functions:
Pan of bars 9x13 or larger uncut
Sandwiches – 2 dozen- made of buns or bread slices
Hot dish to serve 10 to 12 people
Workgroup members unable to contribute food or work for an event are asked to contribute \$20.00. Please give the money to your workgroup chairperson.

Members and non-members are responsible for cleaning up or hiring someone to clean for them.

The church must be ready for the next worship service. All chairs in the dining room should be put on the chair rack. The white tables may be left up. The kitchen needs to be put back in order. Make sure the bathrooms are tidy. Trash should be bagged and put in the garbage containers out back of the church. Sanctuary hymnals should be put back in the racks of the pews. Items left in the church should be picked up. Carpets should be vacuumed if necessary. Any items belonging to the church should not leave the church without permission from the WELCA co-chair or the church president. Zoar Church council established a policy regarding the use of the church's tables and chairs: Chairs may be used for \$1 a chair, only the older brown tables

may be rented for \$5.00 each, **the white tables should not leave the church.**

Menus served for funeral lunches and costs for non-members. These are the only meals prepared, any special requests will need to be handled by an area caterer. Prices subject to change.

1. Scalloped potatoes and ham, green beans, dinner roll, bars, coffee and lemonade.

Non-members \$5.00 per plate

2. Hot ham and cheese bun, coleslaw noodle salad, pickles, bars, coffee and lemonade.

Non-members \$4.00 per plate

3. Deli meat bun, (ham, turkey or chicken depending on availability), coleslaw noodle salad, pickles, bars, coffee and lemonade.

Non-member \$3.25 per plate

4. Meat and cheese tray with assorted crackers, bars, coffee and lemonade

Non-members \$2.75 per person

5. Bars, assorted crackers, coffee and lemonade

Non-members \$2.00 per person

Number of meals charged is based on the number provided by the funeral home in advance. All leftover food will be sent with family.
